In Genesis, we learn about the true story of a man named Abraham and his wife, Sarah. God had big plans for their family and He made Abraham a huge promise. Can you help me find the book of Genesis? Genesis is the first book of the Bible. Let's read Genesis chapter 12, verses 2 and 3.

AND I WILL MAKE OF YOU A GREAT NATION, AND I WILL BLESS YOU AND MAKE YOUR NAME GREAT, SO THAT YOU WILL BE A BLESSING. I WILL BLESS THOSE WHO BLESS YOU, AND HIM WHO DISHONORS YOU I WILL GURSE, AND IN YOU ALL THE FAMILIES OF THE EARTH SHALL BE BLESSED.



## **GENESIS 12:2-3**

God told Abraham the whole world would be blessed because of his family! But Abraham was super old and he didn't even have any kids! The promise of even one child seemed so incredible that Abraham and Sarah both laughed about it! **But God always keeps His promises.** 

Abraham believed God would do what He said. When God decided the time was right, Sarah did have a baby! They named their son Isaac. Their kids and grandkids, and all the children who came after them became known as the <a href="Israelites">Israelites</a>\*. Did you know Jesus, our Savior, was part of God's chosen people, the Israelites, too?














# When Jesus was born He fulfilled the long-ago promise God made to



## **CREATE**



Create a family tree using photographs to help your little ones see family connections and relationships. Allow them to decorate the tree using their favorite art mediums.

## SING



Teach your kids the motions to the song "Father Abraham." Explain that when the song says, "I am one of them and so are you," it is referring to the fact that through Christ we all become sons and daughters of God.



Who was the first person in your family to come to faith? How has that faith been passed down from generation to generation? Take time to pray for family members by name so that they, too, would become part of the family of God.

## **CELEBRATE**



Set aside time this week to commemorate your "spiritual" birthdays into the family of God. Explain how there is great rejoicing in heaven when someone comes to faith, and your family can join in that celebration by remembering important spiritual milestones.

#### **HOW DO I BECOME PART OF THE FAMILY OF GOD?**

God's family is firmly rooted in the Gospel of Jesus Christ. If you believe in the Lord Jesus and trust Him — that He died for our sins, was buried and rose again — you will be saved (Acts 16:31, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4). This week's verse tells us that when we trust in Christ's gift of forgiveness, we become part of God's family.

#### WHAT MAKES THE ISRAELITES SO SPECIAL?

The very short answer is that God chose them in His wisdom and mercy. Romans 9 explains that a potter decides what to make out of his clay, not the other way around. God, as the Potter, our loving Creator, fashions people for whatever purpose He sees fit. He chose to use the Israelites, who we now call the Jewish people, in a special way to make known His plan of redemption on Earth. Jesus may have come to us **through** the Jewish people, but He came to save **anyone** who is lost and far from God.

#### WHAT IF THINGS AREN'T GREAT IN MY FAMILY?


Families aren't perfect. Different families will have different trials. Sometimes the effects of sin on families can be painful. It is important to remember that God can redeem any situation in any family if its members are willing to repent, turn from their sin and follow Him. Remember, even if your family isn't perfect, followers of Jesus are part of the perfect family of God! He loves and cares for you, and knows everything about you.

In situations of danger or abuse, it is important to seek appropriate help to ensure each family member's physical and emotional safety.

# ADDITIONAL PASSAGES YOUR FAMILY CAN READ TOGETHER:

- Read more about the promises made to Abraham's descendants in **GENESIS 12:1-8**, **13:14-18**, **15**, **17-18**, **21:1-7**.
- **ROMANS 9** explains why God chose to bring Jesus to the world through the nation of Israel.
- **GALATIANS 3:26-29** provides a beautiful complement and summary to the teaching found in Romans 9.
