FIND

SNACK



Try this option during snack time! You will need a bag of pretzel sticks. Help your child spell out the word "praise" with the pretzel sticks (and maybe eat a couple along the way).

When finished, ask them to share one thing they would like to praise God for.




Make a thankful tree with your kids. Cut a tree trunk from brown craft paper. Create "leaves" from your child's handprints cut out of construction paper.
