





# THINK ABOUT ONE OF YOUR FAVORITE STORIES. DOES IT HAVE A GOOD PERSON AND A BAD PERSON? A HERO AND A VILLAIN? Most

stories do. The villain does bad things that cause

people pain and suffering, but then the hero comes into the story, stops the villain and saves the day!

The story of Earth has a hero and villain too. If you flip back in your Bible to the first book called Genesis, you will learn the **true story** about the first man and woman God created — Adam and Eve.

God created the perfect place for Adam and Eve called the garden of Eden. There, Adam and Eve had perfect fellowship with God.

God warned Adam and Eve not to eat from one tree in the garden, but guess what Adam and Eve did? They listened to the villain, a crafty serpent, who told them to disobey God and eat what God specifically told them not to. Both Adam and Eve chose to sin. **Help** me find Genesis 3:14-19 to learn the <u>true story</u> of what happened after Adam and Eve ate what God told them not to.













# TALK TOGETHER





THE LORD GOD SAID TO THE SERPENT, "BECAUSE YOU HAVE DONE THIS, CURSED ARE YOU ABOVE ALL LIVESTOCK AND ABOVE ALL BEASTS OF THE FIELD; ON YOUR BELLY YOU SHALL GO, AND DUST YOU SHALL EAT ALL THE DAYS OF YOUR LIFE. I WILL PUT ENMITY BETWEEN YOU AND THE WOMAN, AND BETWEEN YOUR OFFSPRING AND HER OFFSPRING; HE SHALL BRUISE YOUR HEAD, AND YOU SHALL BRUISE HIS HEEL."

TO THE WOMAN HE SAID, I WILL SURELY MULTIPLY YOUR PAIN IN CHILDBEARING; IN PAIN YOU SHALL BRING FORTH CHILDREN. YOUR DESIRE SHALL BE CONTRARY TO YOUR HUSBAND, BUT HE SHALL RULE OVER YOU.

AND TO ADAM HE SAID, "BEGAUSE YOU HAVE LISTENED TO THE VOIGE OF YOUR WIFE AND HAVE EATEN OF THE TREE OF WHIGH I COMMANDED YOU, 'YOU SHALL NOT EAT OF IT,' CURSED IS THE GROUND BECAUSE OF YOU; IN PAIN YOU SHALL EAT OF IT ALL THE DAYS OF YOUR LIFE; THORNS AND THISTLES IT SHALL BRING FORTH FOR YOU; AND YOU SHALL EAT THE PLANTS OF THE FIELD. BY THE SWEAT OF YOUR FACE YOU SHALL EAT BREAD, TILL YOU RETURN TO THE GROUND, FOR OUT OF IT YOU WERE TAKEN; FOR YOU ARE DUST, AND TO DUST YOU SHALL RETURN."




**GENESIS 3:14-19**

#### FIND IT IN THE BIBLE: **ROMANS**

This week's verse comes from the book of Romans. Romans is an epistle, or letter. The book was written by the missionary Paul. In this letter, Paul writes to the Romans and clearly presents the Gospel, the good news about lesus!

#### WHY DO I HAVE TO DEAL WITH THE CONSEQUENCES OF ADAM AND EVE'S SIN?

Like we learned by reading this week's memory verse, Romans 5:12, ALL have sinned. We all make a choice to sin once we are born in this world and should not think that we would have chosen differently in the garden of Eden. (Romans 3:23)

### **OT-NT CONNECTION**

Adam was the first man to live on Earth, but his decision to sin impacted people in the Old Testament, New Testament and anyone who has ever lived. Let's read about it in Romans 5:12-14.

- What does verse 14 say reigned from Adam to Moses?
- How has sin impacted your life?

# **JOURNAL**

Sin is awful. God did not want sin to be part of our lives. He wrote a beautiful story for us to live sin-free! Sadly, Adam and Eve chose to sin.

Write a short story of what you think it would be like to live in the garden of Eden before Adam and Eve chose to sin.

#### **HOW DO I STOP SINNING?**

While we are on this earth, we won't stop struggling with sin until we get to heaven. Anyone who has accepted Jesus as their Savior can become more like Jesus by reading and thinking about His Word and the Bible, and talking to Him through prayer. When faced with temptation, we can ask God to help us make good choices. (**John 16:13**)

#### READ

When we choose to sin, it always affects us; but it often impacts those around us, too.

Read Genesis 4:1-16 to learn how the effects of sin impacted not only Adam and Eve but also their children (and everyone else on Earth).

#### **SHARE**



Share with your family about a time you chose to sin instead of following Jesus. What happened? When you realized you messed up, what did you do?

#### **PRAY**



DEAR GOD, PLEASE HELP US AVOID SIN AND FOLLOW YOU. WHEN WE ARE TEMPTED, HELP US ASK YOU FOR HELP. WE WANT TO BRING YOU GLORY, AMEN.

#### CREATE



Provide your child with a handful of pipe cleaners and ask them to spell their name. Then, straighten all the pipe cleaners back out and ask them to try again with their eyes closed. Explain how sin blinds us and makes it hard to do what God asks us to. Thankfully, if we ask, God will guide our decisions and help us avoid sin.

#### DROP



Gather together a bowl of water and 1 bottle of food coloring. Have your child add just 1 drop of food coloring to the water and see what happens. If you mix the drop around, it contaminates the entire bowl of water. That's what sin does to our lives and it's why we need a Savior (Jesus) to save us.

### **SNACK**



God provided Adam and Eve with lots of delicious things to eat in the garden of Eden. Sadly, they chose to eat from the one thing God told them not to.

Thinking about the great things God provided Adam and Eve to eat in the garden of Eden, help your child pick out some of their favorite fruits and make a fruit salad together.
