



When you fall asleep at night, it's comforting to know a random person can't walk into your house. When it's locked, only people with a key that matches your house lock can come in. Only one key will open the door.

Just like one key opens the door to your home, believing Jesus Christ died and rose again for your sins and asking Him to be your Savior is the only way to heaven.

The missionary Paul spent many years of his life telling people about lesus. He was thrown in prison multiple times for saying lesus was the only way to heaven. But even in prison, Paul shared Jesus with the people around him.

One day, Paul found himself before a king named Agrippa. The king allowed Paul to explain why he was a prisoner. Paul told Agrippa how Jesus changed his life. Then Paul asked the king if he would believe in Jesus. Help me find Acts 26:26-32 to read what he said.

THEN THE KING ROSE, AND THE GOVERNOR AND BERNICE AND THOSE WHO WERE SITTING WITH THEM. AND WHEN THEY HAD WITHDRAWN, THEY SAID TO ONE ANOTHER, "THIS MAN IS DOING NOTHING TO DESERVE DEATH OR IMPRISONMENT." AND AGRIPPA SAID TO FESTUS, "THIS MAN COULD HAVE BEEN SET FREE IF HE HAD NOT APPEALED TO CAESAR."

ACTS 26:26-32

HOW DID KING AGRIPPA RESPOND TO PAUL'S QUESTION?

Sadly, King Agrippa did not make Jesus his Savior that day. We don't know if his heart changed later in life because the Bible does not say. **What we do know is Paul spoke the truth and followed God's Word to share the Gospel.**

There may be times when you share the Gospel with someone and they do not accept God's gift of salvation. But you can continue to pray for God to change their heart and change their mind! And, you can continue to share God's Word with them!

Remember, there is only one way to heaven and that is through Jesus Christ. As you grow older, people will try to convince you there are other ways to heaven. They will tell you to do good things or follow other religions to get to heaven. Those things won't work.


Just like there is only one key that can unlock the door to your home, there is only one way to heaven: belief in Jesus Christ.

MORE TO EXPLORE WEEK OF JULY 16, 2023



FIND IT IN THE BIBLE:

This week's story comes from the book of Acts. Acts is the only book of its kind in the New Testament and is not grouped with any other books. It tells the story of the earliest Christians.

The book is written by the physician Luke and picks up where the book of Luke left off. Acts introduces readers to the missionary Paul and shares how the Gospel spread to other countries.

JOURNAL

Ask an adult to help you find a lock and key that go together. Take a close look at the grooves in the key and the entrance to the lock. Only one key will open the lock.

Think about how Jesus is the only way to heaven. Now think about how important it is to share your faith with people who don't know Jesus.

Trace the key in your journal as a reminder that Jesus is the only way to heaven.

OT-NT CONNECTION

In Acts 4:11-12, Paul declares Jesus is the only way to be saved and references the Old Testament. **Read Psalm** 118:22-29 to learn what Old Testament verses Paul connects to Jesus.

- What two things are mentioned in both the Old Testament and New Testament? (Hint: Look at Acts 4:11 and Psalm 118:22.)
- Jesus is the cornerstone! Have you decided to accept Jesus as your Savior?

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO SHARE THE GOSPEL WITH OTHER PEOPLE?

Jesus tells His followers in **Matthew 28** to share the Gospel with other people. When we share the Gospel, people learn about the only way to heaven and can come to know Jesus!

WHAT IF I SHARE MY FAITH WITH SOMEONE AND THEY TILL DON'T WANT JESUS?

While we are called to share the good news about Jesus with other people, we are not responsible for their decision. That's what God does. Every person must decide for themselves whether they want to follow Jesus. But anyone who chooses to believe in Him will be saved! (John 3:16)

READ

Check out the story of Paul and King Agrippa. **Read Acts 26.** King Agrippa did not choose to accept Jesus as his Savior after Paul shared his faith. Do you think Paul's testimony impacted King Agrippa?

FIND

SHARE

Tell your kids about a time you (or someone you know) told someone about Jesus but the person did not accept Jesus as their Savior. What happened, and do you still pray for that person?

NAVIGATE

Draw a simple maze (with one answer) for your child to navigate. Jesus is the only one who can help us navigate this life. He is the only one who can offer us salvation.

Sometimes we share the Gospel with someone, but they choose not to accept Jesus as their Savior. That doesn't mean they never will. God can use us to plant "seeds" in people's lives. Sometimes, later in life, people will remember the truth about Jesus and decide to become saved.

Help your child plant a seed! Water it, give it sunlight and watch it grow! Remind them that we are not responsible for making people accept Jesus, only for sharing the Gospel with them.

UNLOCK

Give your child a key ring full of keys and ask them to unlock the front door. Don't tell them what key is the right key. Once they've accomplished the task. Explain that just like there is only one key that unlocks the front door, there is only one way to get to heaven. The only way a person can go to heaven is to believe the Gospel and accept Jesus as their Savior.




