TALK TOGETHER

MY SON, IF YOU RECEIVE MY WORDS AND TREASURE UP MY COMMANDMENTS WITH YOU, MAKING YOUR EAR ATTENTIVE TO WISDOM AND INCLINING YOUR HEART TO UNDERSTANDING: YES, IF YOU CALL OUT FOR INSIGHT AND RAISE YOUR VOICE FOR UNDERSTANDING, IF YOU SEEK IT LIKE SILVER AND SEARCH FOR IT AS FOR HIDDEN TREASURES, THEN YOU WILL UNDERSTAND THE FEAR OF THE LORD AND FIND THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD. FOR THE LORD GIVES WISDOM; FROM HIS MOUTH COME KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING; HE STORES UP SOUND WISDOM FOR THE UPRIGHT; HE IS A SHIELD TO THOSE WHO WALK IN INTEGRITY, GUARDING THE PATHS OF JUSTICE AND WATCHING OVER THE WAY OF HIS SAINTS.



PROVERBS 2:1-8

Did you catch where wisdom comes from? It comes from the Lord, our Creator! The more we pursue getting to know God, the wiser we will become. Why? Because God is the source of true wisdom. I don't know about you, but I could sure use more of God's wisdom in my life!

Proverbs says wisdom brings an understanding of righteousness, justice and equity. Those are big words, huh? Think of it this way:

- God's wisdom will help us live life like lesus.
- God's wisdom will help us make the right decisions.
- God's wisdom will help us treat others fairly!

God's Word says wisdom is something we should search for, like a hidden treasure chest! Can you imagine how excited you'd be if you found a box stuffed with gold, rubies and pearls? Wisdom is more precious than any of those things because it helps us make choices that honor God.

Life will throw some tricky, sticky and even icky situations in your path. You'll need God's wisdom to make good choices that keep you safe from the evil in this world. Don't wait until you're old to start your search for wisdom. Follow God's map (the Bible) and ask Him for wisdom to help you make wise choices today, tomorrow and every day of this life!

FIND IT IN THE BIBLE: PROVERBS

This week's story comes from the book of Proverbs. Proverbs is one of several books that fall under the category of poetry and wisdom. At least part of the book was written by Solomon, the wisest man to ever live. This book shares with its readers wisdom for godly living.

HOW DO I BECOME WISE?

Proverbs 2 tells us to search for wisdom as we would treasure! It also tells us wisdom comes from the Lord. Wisdom can be found by following God, learning about Him in the Bible and asking Him for wisdom through prayer.

OT-NT CONNECTION

In the New Testament book of 1 Corinthians, Paul says something incredible about the wisdom of God. **Read 1 Corinthians 1:25.**

- What does Paul say about the foolishness of God?

 Note: Our almighty God is not foolish. The point Paul makes in this verse is that the wisest man on Earth cannot begin to compare with the wisdom of God.
- What could you use some of God's wisdom for in your life?

JOURNAL

Think about your favorite book or movie that features a treasure hunt. What is the treasure in that story? The Bible compares wisdom to silver and hidden treasures. Write a short poem comparing wisdom to treasure and thanking God for sharing His wisdom with us.

CAN I BE WISE ALL THE TIME?

Not until we get to heaven! Sin prevents us from always making wise decisions, but thankfully God is the source of wisdom and He is bigger than sin! Jesus defeated sin on the cross. Christians can ask God for wisdom and learn more about Him through the Bible. He is the only One who can help us make wise decisions.

READ



Proverbs 2, verses 1-4 lists several actions we should take to pursue wisdom. Read those verses again. What are they?

MAKE



Ask your child to choose a color of construction paper and help them cut out the shape of a gemstone. Write, "Wisdom comes from the Lord" on the center of the gemstone. Let them decorate it. Once finished, help them hang their masterpiece in their room.

SEARCH



We should search for God's wisdom throughout our life, like someone searches for treasure!

Hide an object (a piece of candy, a note to your child, a fun, cheap toy) in your house and draw a map to it. Help your child follow the map to find the treasure. Remind them we need to search for God's wisdom just like we would search for treasure.

EAT



Gather some pretzel sticks and help your child spell out the word wisdom. While you munch on your masterpiece, ask them to share one thing they learned about wisdom from today's lesson.

SING
