





# HAS ANYONE EVER SAVED YOU FROM A TOUGH SITUATION?

Maybe a friend saved you from stepping in a mud puddle on a rainy day. Or perhaps an adult

saved you from a dangerous situation. Can you tell me about what happened?

In the Old Testament, God saved His people from slavery! The Israelites had been trapped for a long time as slaves in a place called Egypt. God spoke to a man named Moses. He told him to lead the Israelites out of Egypt and take them to a new home.

Moses obeyed God. He led the Israelites out of Egypt, but there was a big problem. The Egyptians did not want their slaves to leave. Their leader, Pharaoh, commanded his warriors to take their horses and chariots and chase the Israelites.

Eventually, the Egyptians caught up to the Israelites. A large body of water called the Red Sea prevented the Israelites from going any further. Panic gripped the people, but God knew what to do. He told Moses to lift his staff. Moses obeyed, and the sea split into two halves!











# TALK TOGETHER

It stayed that way long enough for the Israelites to cross. Then God closed the waters on the Egyptians. God saved His people!

The Israelites were so thankful they began to worship God! They praised Him with a song. Let's read about it in Exodus 15:1-6.

THEN MOSES AND THE PEOPLE OF ISRAEL SANG THIS SONG TO THE LORD, SAYING, I WILL SING TO THE LORD, FOR HE HAS TRIUMPHED GLORIOUSLY: THE HORSE AND HIS RIDER HE HAS THROWN INTO THE SEA. THE LORD IS MY STRENGTH AND MY SONG, AND HE HAS BECOME MY SALVATION; THIS IS MY GOD, AND I WILL PRAISE HIM, MY FATHER'S GOD, AND I WILL EXALT HIM. THE LORD IS A MAN OF WAR; THE LORD IS HIS NAME. "PHARAOH'S CHARIOTS AND HIS HOST HE CAST INTO THE SEA, AND HIS CHOSEN OFFICERS WERE SUNK IN THE RED SEA. THE FLOODS GOVERED THEM: THEY WENT DOWN INTO THE DEPTHS LIKE A STONE. YOUR RIGHT HAND, O LORD, GLORIOUS IN POWER, YOUR RIGHT HAND, O LORD, SHATTERS THE ENEMY.



(EXODUS 15:1-6)

What does Moses say he will do in verse two? He says he will praise God! When we praise God, we celebrate Him, and we glorify Him. He is our almighty God. He is the only one Who deserves our praise.

God saved the Israelites in a big way, but guess what? He's offered to save you in a big way, too. When Jesus died on the cross, He paid the penalty for everyone's sins. When He rose again, He defeated death. Jesus made salvation available to anyone who trusts Him as their Savior.

If you are a Christian, God has saved you from a tough situation. He's saved you from sin, and He loves you fiercely. **Praise God for His gift of salvation!**

# FIND IT IN THE BIBLE: **EXODUS**

This week's story comes from the book of Exodus. Exodus is one of five books in the Old Testament known as the Pentateuch.

This book tells us how God takes care of His people. It details the Israelites' escape from Egypt and their journey to the Promised Land.

#### **OT-NT CONNECTION**

The way God took care of the Israelites in Exodus was not forgotten in the New Testament. **Take a look at Hebrews 11:23-40**.

- What does verse 29 say?
- What is something God did in the past for you or a family member that you can still praise Him for?

# WHAT ARE SOME WAYS TO GIVE GOD PRAISE?

There are many ways we can praise God! A couple of ways include praising Him through music (Psalm 147:1), praising Him by serving with gladness (Psalm 100:2) and thanking Him when we talk to Him through prayer (Philippians 4:6).

## **READ**



Finish reading Exodus 15. The Israelites praised God for saving them from the Egyptians and parting the Red Sea.

Now, ask an adult today to help you look up how wide and deep the Red Sea is.

# DOES GOD LOVE US LIKE HE LOVED THE ISRAELITES?

Yes. God loves you so much He sent His Son to die for your sins (John 3:16)! Because of this, we can join Him in heaven if we accept Jesus as our Savior. We should thank God for His amazing love for us.

## CREATE



Our God is powerful! Help your child understand how God parted the Red Sea to save the Israelites. Dye some rice blue with food coloring. Take a piece of paper and place glue on the right and left sides, but leave a strip in the middle blank. Pour the colored rice all over the paper. Now hold the paper up. Rice will fall away from the middle where there is no glue! There will be a path through the rice, just like God made a path through the sea.
